Google Classroom is a **learning environment** which Google opened in August 2014. It is available for all who have a Google account (since 2020, you also were able to join with a PIN code). The product is part of Google's and other media companies' effort to open a new market in the learning industry.

Classroom makes it easier to store, edit, and share learning resources. Its mission is to help instructors create and collect tasks **paperlessly**. They can easily copy a Google document automatically to all students. The application makes it easier to organize a classroom sessions by creating a separate Drive folder for each task and each student. Instructors can quickly check which students have done the exercises. They are also able to give feedback in real-time in Classroom.
