Wireless network eduroam



General

eduroam is an international university and research organization roaming service that Metropolia is now a member of. Those affiliated with Metropolia can access the network while visiting other eduroam member organizations using their own user accounts and the other way around.

All Metropolia public services and internet [guest network services](#) are available in the network. There is no access to Metropolia internal services via the guest network.

Certificate used for authentication: **METROPOLIA_CA.cer**

User name for the eduroam has to be in form of **username@metropolia.fi**

2.1 Installing certificate from the Settings

Some phone models may send notification like this after you try to open the certificate:

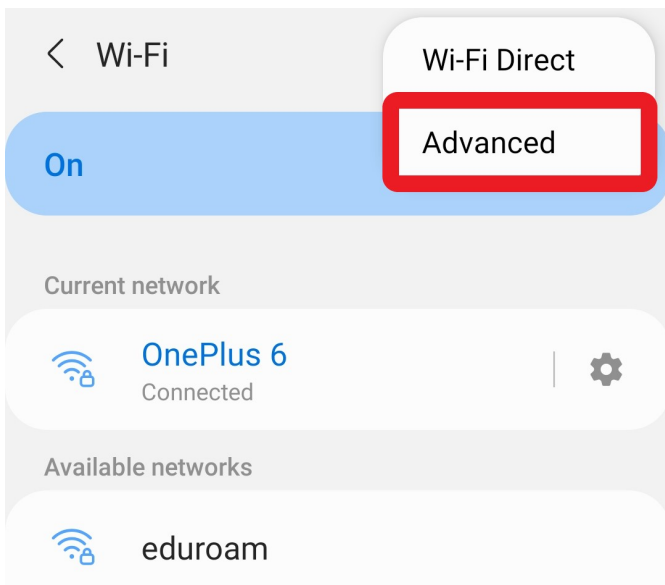

This certificate from null must be installed in Settings. Only install CA certificates from organizations you trust.

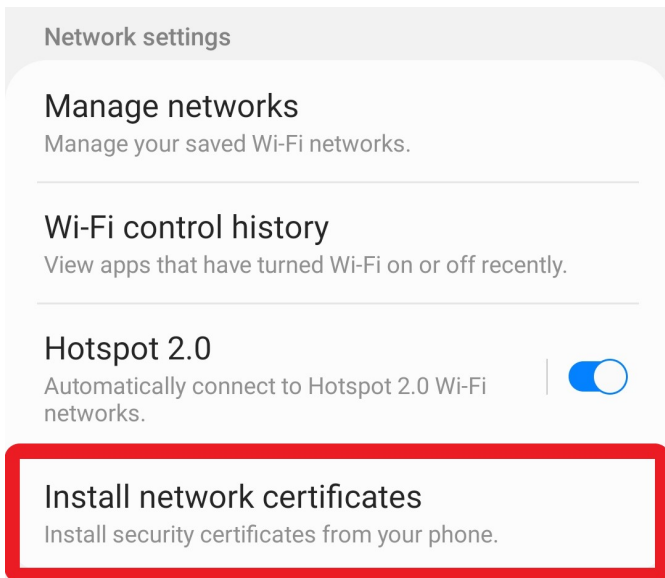

If you **didn't** get this message, go to [Configuring the certificate](#). Else:

1. Open **Settings** and go to **WiFi-settings**.
2. Open the **menu** and select **Advanced**.

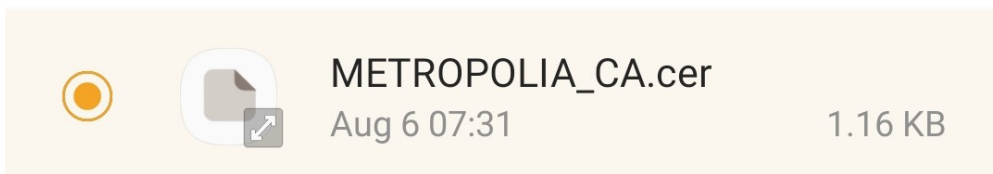


3. Select **Install network certificates**.



4. Open **Downloads**-folder.

5. Select **METROPOLIA_CA.cer** and press **Done**.



6. Name the certificate as **Metropolia_CA**.

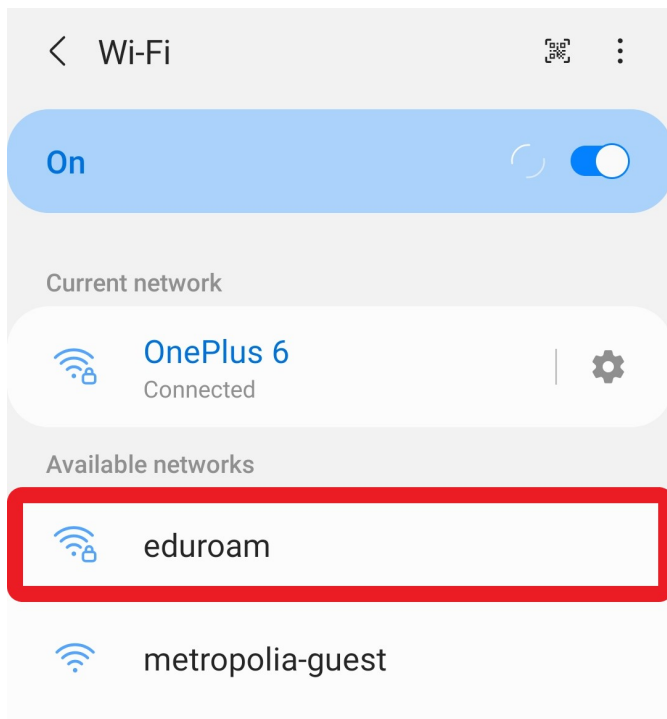
